



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

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

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## Markup Summary

Per Land Development Code Section 6.2.2.D.2.iii: There shall be a 15 foot landscaping buffer on the residential side of the project



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Per Land Development Code Section 6.2.2.D.2.iii:

There shall be a 15 foot landscaping buffer on the residential side of the project when use to use compatibility is a concern.

The minimum number of trees in the buffer shall be one tree for every 25 feet of common lot, parcel, or tract line. A minimum of 1/3 of the trees shall be evergreen trees.

An opaque fence or wall with a minimum height of 6 feet is required along the lot, parcel, or tract line. Bark, wood chips, rock, stone, or other natural landscape material shall be used as a non-living ground cover. Areas of a required buffer not covered in approved non-living ground cover material shall be covered in a living plant material.

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
