Regarding your cover letter dated June 26, 2020, there is some clarification needed. Your letter stated the following:

"There also appears to be several areas of wetlands with approximate locations shown on the drainage plan. An application for a Nationwide Permit has been recently submitted to the Army Corps of Engineers. It is expected that a biologist from their field office will conduct a site visit to identify the wetland areas. Once the boundaries of the wetlands are determined they will be field located and shown on the plat."

In order for the US Fish and Wildlife Service (Service) to follow the appropriate consultation pathway for your project, it will necessary to first determine whether there will be an issuance of any permits by the US Army Corps of Engineers (USACE). The project consists of subdividing one (1) large tract into 4 lots each having an area greater than 5 acres. The existing roadway, Forest Heights Circle, is a private gravel road that extends approximately 2400 feet east of the Herring Road intersection. Construction will be limited to increasing the travel lanes from an average width of 18 feet to 24 feet (2-12-foot lanes). There are three existing 18" CMP culverts that are also to be removed and replaced with 24" CMP. It is hoped that construction can begin later this summer.
