Dear Becky,

As per your request for treatment capacity, the Tri-Lakes Wastewater Treatment Facility's design capacity is 4.2 million gallons per day (MGD) and 5,600 pounds of biological oxygen demand (BOD) per day. During the past 12 months the facility averaged 1.22 MGD or 29% of the hydraulic capacity and 3,397 pounds of BOD per day or 61% of the organic capacity.

Annual reports are no longer required in our discharge permit. The last annual report that was submitted from Tri-Lakes Wastewater Treatment Facility to the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment was in April of 1997.
