## Verification of Administrative Relief:

An Administrative Relief was requested on January 20, 2109. The whelping kennel (Bldg 3) and the loafing shed (Bldg 6) cannot be relocated to 200 feet so a fee of \$587 will be paid once the Administrative Relief form has been reviewed. We've completed this process and have turned it in to your office.

## Landscaping:

The landscaping has been added to the site development plan and will be constructed before being issued a Certificate of Occupancy.

## Well Permit:

We have received approval from the Colorado Division of Water Resources for a change of use of our existing well for kennel purposes (#3 on the permit). The well permit number is 312384 and was issued on January 17, 2019.

## Alternative Landscaping Design:

An Alternative Landscaping Design has been requested. We have strategically placed shrubs and a fence around the kennel house on the site development plan and drawing.
