This letter is being written in accordance to the El Paso County Land Development Code 6.3.3.B.1.

Peyton Fire Protection District responds with FIRE, EMS, and haz-mat capabilities. The department responds with any number of it's one tender unit, two brush trucks, one engine, rescue vehicle, and one pumper/tender. All are housed at a single location at 13665 Railroad St. Peyton, Colorado 80831.

Being a volunteer department response time varies due to availability of personnel and location in the district but, on an average Peyton Fire Protection Districts response to is ten minutes from time of dispatch to time of equipment leaving the station.

As stated earlier Peyton Fire Protection District provides fire prevention and suppression services both structure and wild and, BLS emergency medical services, and operations level haz-mat response.
