PERMIT TO USE AN EXISTING WELL

ISSUANCE OF THIS PERMIT DOES NOT CONFER A WATER RIGHT

CONDITIONS OF APPROVAL

- 1) This well shall be used in such a way as to cause no material injury to existing water rights. The issuance of this permit does not ensure that no injury will occur to another vested water right or preclude another owner of a vested water right from seeking relief in a civil court action.
- 2) The construction of this well shall be in compliance with the Water Well Construction Rules 2 CCR 402-2, unless approval of a variance has been granted by the State Board of Examiners of Water Well Construction and Pump Installation Contractors in accordance with Rule 18.
- 3) Approved pursuant to CRS 37-90-107(7) and the Findings and Order of the Colorado Ground Water Commission dated July 8, 2019, for Determination of Water Right No. 3736-BD for a change of use of an existing well constructed under permit no. 181032.
- 4) Issuance of this permit cancels permit no. 181032.
- 5) The pumping rate of this well shall not exceed 25 GPM.
- 6) The annual withdrawal of ground water from this well shall not exceed 3 acre-feet, subject to the total annual withdrawal limitations and conditions as specified by the above referenced Order of the Commission.
- 7) The use of ground water from this well is limited to domestic use inside 3 single family dwellings, including the watering of domestic animals and the irrigation of 1 acre of lawns and gardens. The place of use shall be limited to the 40 acre land area claimed in the above described Order of the Commission.
- 8) Production is limited to the Denver aquifer.
- 9) The owner shall mark the well in a conspicuous location with the well permit number and name of aquifer as appropriate, and shall take necessary means and precautions to preserve these markings.
- 10) This well shall have been constructed within 200 feet of the location specified on this permit. This well shall not be located within 600 feet of another large-capacity well completed in the Denver aquifer.
- 11) A totalizing flow meter or Commission approved measuring device must be installed on this well and maintained in good working order. Permanent records of all diversions must be maintained by the well owner (collected at least annually) and submitted to the Upper Black Squirrel Creek Ground Water Management District and the Ground Water Commission upon request.
- 12) At least four percent (4%) of the amount of water withdrawn annually must be returned to the uppermost aquifer in the vicinity of the well.

NOTE: The ability of this well to withdraw its authorized amount of water from this non-renewable aquifer may be less than the 100 years upon which the amount of water in the aquifer is allocated, due to anticipated water level declines.

NOTE: This well is located within the Upper Black Squirrel Creek Ground Water Management District where local District Rules apply which may further limit the withdrawal and use of designated ground water as authorized under this permit. The District requires permanent records of all diversions be maintained and collected monthly.
