Dear Kari,

I am in receipt of a request for comment on a Temporary Use to allow an event described as Carnival or Circus on June 18, 19, & 20 on the Western Mining Museum property located on the east side of I-25 and south of Northgate Blvd. Our comments follow:

- CDOT requires a Colorado State Patrol (CSP) Event Permit be obtained and provided to CDOT.
- Proof of written notification to the USAFA before CDOT will recommend approval.
- The Traffic Control Plan will be forwarded to a CDOT Operations Engineer for review and comment. Additional comments will be forthcoming.

Additionally,

- On-premise and off-premise signing shall comply with the current Colorado Outdoor Advertising Act, sections 43-1-401 to 421, C.R.S., and all rules and regulations pertaining to outdoor advertising. Please contact Mr. Todd Ausbun at 719-696-1403 for any questions regarding advertising devices.
- Any utility work within the state highway right of way will require a utility permit from the CDOT. Information for obtaining a utility permit can also be obtained by contacting Mr. Ausbun.
