The Pikes Peak Celtic Festival intends to hold its 8th annual festival on June 18 – 20, 2021 at:

The three-day festival in 2019 saw an estimated 4,990 tickets sold to the event which is held over a three-day period making the average daily attendance ~1,700. Current attendance estimates are about 80% following current ticketing trends.

The festival includes one music stage with Celtic music groups playing though out the hours of the festival. Cultural competition such as highland athletic competition and highland bagpipe competition also happen throughout the weekend.

There is a variety of food vendors, merchandise vendors, cultural family heritage organizations (Clans) and imported beer sold at the festival.
