## Waterbury, Filing 2, SF-17-019

Please accept the following comments from El Paso County Public Health regarding the project referenced above:

- The proposed 72 unit residential development will be provided water and wastewater services through 4 Way Ranch Metropolitan District.
- There is a finding for sufficiency in terms of water quality for drinking water obtained from this Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment, Water Quality Control Division, regulated central water supply. The Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment assigned PWSID# is CO0121111.
- There is sufficient wastewater treatment capacity at 4 Way Ranch Metropolitan District through an agreement with Woodmen Hills Metropolitan District to properly treat the projected wastewater flows from the proposed development project. A 14July2017 commitment letter from 4 Way Ranch Metropolitan District outlines the agreement.
- Radon resistant construction building techniques/practices are encouraged to be used in this area. The EPA has determined that Colorado, and the El Paso County area, have potentially higher radon levels than other areas of the country.
- Earthmoving activity in excess of one acre, but less than twenty-five acres, will require a local Construction Activity Permit from El Paso County Public Health.
