ISSUANCE OF THIS PERMIT DOES NOT CONFER A WATER RIGHT
CONDITIONS OF APPROVAL

- 1) This well shall be used in such a way as to cause no material injury to existing water rights. The issuance of this permit does not ensure that no injury will occur to another vested water right or preclude another owner of a vested water right from seeking relief in a civil court action.
- 2) The construction of this well shall be in compliance with the Water Well Construction Rules 2 CCR 402-2, unless approval of a variance has been granted by the State Board of Examiners of Water Well Construction and Pump Installation Contractors in accordance with Rule 18.
- 3) Approved pursuant to CRS 37-92-602(3)(c) for the relocation of an existing well, permit no. 296727. The old well must be plugged in accordance with Rule 16 of the Water Well Construction Rules within ninety-one (91) days of completion of the new well. The enclosed Well Abandonment Report form must be completed and submitted to affirm that the old well was plugged.
- 4) The use of ground water from this well is limited to fire protection, ordinary household purposes inside not more than one (1) single family dwelling (including a barn/carriage house), the irrigation of not more than one (1) acre of home gardens and lawns, and the watering of domestic animals and poultry. This well is to be located on a 3.46 acre parcel described as lot 19, block 4, tract 1, Brentwood Country Club and Cabin Sites.
- 5) The total depth of the well shall not exceed 815 feet, which corresponds to the base of the Dawson aquifer. At a minimum, plain casing shall be installed and grouted through all unconsolidated materials and shall extend a minimum of ten feet into the bedrock formation to prevent production from other zones.
- 6) The pumping rate of this well shall not exceed 15 GPM.
- 7) This well shall be constructed not more than 200 feet from the location specified on this permit.

NOTE: To ensure a maximum productive life of this well, perforated casing should be set through the entire producing interval of the approved zone or aquifer indicated above.

NOTE: This permit will expire on the expiration date unless the well is constructed by that date. A Well Construction and Test Report (GWS-31) must be submitted to the Division of Water Resources to verify the well has been constructed. An extension of the expiration date may be available.
