I am in receipt of a referral request for Bradley Point Site Development located The 9.5-acre site is located north of the intersection formed by Highway 85/87 (Category NR-A MP 135.67 R) and South Academy Boulevard, in the El Paso County, State of Colorado. The project proposes an outdoor landscaping material storage facility. One Full Movement access from state highway 85 has been granted. The property has the tax schedule No. 6503400038 and 6503400040, are currently owned by Bradley Point LLC. After review of submittals, we have the following comments:

## **TRAFFIC**

• As a condition of the access permit the permittee will be required to re-stipe a southbound left turn deceleration lane into the site where the existing painted median exists.

## **HYDRAULICS**

The Drainage Report and Grading Plan has not been reviewed, please provide.

- Provide a Drainage Letter/Report
  - Drainage to the state highway right-of-way shall not exceed the undeveloped historical rate of flow
  - o Provide plans and hydraulic analysis of existing detention basin
  - Describe hydrology & hydraulics methods, including intensity equations, within the body of the report

## **ACCESS**

Permit 222166 to relocate the existing undocumented access was issued on 10/18/2022 to serve one Landscape Material Storage Facility. A request for an extension was granted, it expires on 10/5/2024. The Notice to Proceed to construction has not yet been issued.

Additionally,

• On-premise and off-premise signing shall comply with the current Colorado Outdoor Advertising Act, sections 43-1-401 to 421, C.R.S., and all rules and regulations pertaining to

outdoor advertising. Please contact Adam Lancaster at 719-562-5540 for any questions regarding advertising devices.

• Any utility work within the state highway right of way will require a utility permit from the CDOT. Information for obtaining a utility permit can also be obtained by contacting Mr. Lancaster.
