AECOM was retained by the United States Army Corp of Engineers to perform the design and construction of the Drinking Water Mitigation System for the Widefield Water and Sanitation District, Colorado Springs, Colorado. Please see Project Summary and Construction Drawings for additional project details. The following is the plan to obtain the stormwater management acceptance from Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment (CDPHE).

MS4 Plan

AECOM is preparing a Stormwater Management Plan (SWMP) consistent with Urban Drainage Flood Control District (UDFCD) to meet El Paso County's MS4. The SWMP will be provided to El Paso County to review when complete. Prior to construction, the Construction Contractor will coordinate with the CDPHE to obtain an exemption letter or required acceptance by CDPHE for stormwater management and stormwater discharge to state waters in accordance with MS4 requirements. The contractor will provide the exemption letter or acceptance by CDPHE to El Paso County. Although, a stormwater permit may not be required for this project, the contractor will follow the SWMP similar to other permitted projects, in order to maintain compliance with El Paso County's MS4.
