AECOM was retained by the United States Army Corp of Engineers to perform the design and construction of the Drinking Water Mitigation System for the Widefield Water and Sanitation District, Colorado Springs, Colorado. Please see the Project Summary and Construction Drawings for additional project details. The following is the Access Easement Agreement Plan for construction.

Easement Agreement

The project will require obtaining permanent and temporary construction easement. The permanent easement will be approximate 20 feet wide, with 10 feet from both sides of the proposed centerline. An additional 25 feet will be obtained for a temporary construction easement.

AECOM is working with the Widefield Water and Sanitation District to obtain all easement agreements with all impacted parties. Temporary construction easements will only be implemented for the duration of the construction.

Upload the easement agreement once it is obtained.
