Revise the PCM Certification Letter to include the required statements listed in ECM Section 5.10.6.B:

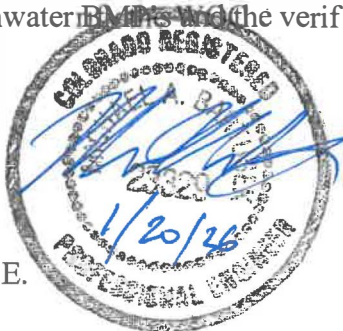
"The site and adjacent properties (as affected by work performed under the County permit) are stable with respect to settlement and subsidence, sloughing of cut and fill slopes, revegetation or other ground cover, and that the improvements (public improvements, common development improvements, site grading and paving) meet or exceed the minimum design requirements. The PCM(s) provide the required storage volume and meet the required release rates, stage areas, elevations, and outlet dimensions, as documented by the attached revised MHFD-Detention spreadsheet that shows the as-built conditions."

The permanent stormwater Best Management Practices (BMPs) for the Judge Orr Rd. RV project located at 14010 Judge Orr Rd., Falcon, CO consists of a 2.532-acre foot Extended Detention Basin (EDB), 0.470 Ac-Ft Water Quality Basin and a 10' gravel maintenance road.

CDS LLC has reviewed the as-built survey for the basin. Based on information gathered during periodic site visits to the project during significant/key phases of the stormwater EDB installation, CDS LLC is of the opinion that the stormwater EDB has been constructed in general compliance with the approved Erosion and Stormwater Quality Control Plan, Construction Plans, and Specifications as filed with El Paso County including all components of the outlet structure which were recently installed.

Statement Of Engineer In Responsible Charge:

I, Michael A. Bartusek, a registered Professional Engineer in the State of Colorado, in accordance with Sections 5.2 and 5.3 of the Bylaws and Rules of the State Board of Registration for Professional Engineers and Professional Land Surveyors, do hereby certify that I or a person under my responsible charge periodically observed the construction of the above-mentioned project. Based on the on-site field observations and review of pertinent documentation, it is my professional opinion that the required permanent EDB has been installed and are in general compliance with the approved Erosion and Stormwater Quality Control Plan, Construction Plans, and Specifications and all existing and proposed swales meet the capacity and velocity requirements as filed with El Paso County. For BMPs with a 0.470 Ac-Ft Water Quality Capture Volume (WQCV), I have attached the post-construction As-Built drawings. The As-Built drawings accurately depict the final installation of the stormwater BMPs and the verify the WQCV..
