ISSUANCE OF THIS PERMIT DOES NOT CONFER A WATER RIGHT

CONDITIONS OF APPROVAL


- 1) This well shall be used in such a way as to cause no material injury to existing water rights. The issuance of this permit does not ensure that no injury will occur to another vested water right or preclude another owner of a vested water right from seeking relief in a civil court action.
- 2) The construction of this well shall be in compliance with the Water Well Construction Rules 2 CCR 402-2, unless approval of a variance has been granted by the State Board of Examiners of Water Well Construction and Pump Installation Contractors in accordance with Rule 18.
- 3) Approved pursuant to CRS 37-90-137(4) on the condition that this well is operated in accordance with the augmentation plan approved by the Division 1 Water Court in Case No. 21CW3119. If the well is not operated in accordance with the terms of said decree, it will be subject to administration including orders to cease diverting water.
- 4) Approved for the change in use of an existing well constructed under permit no. 130940. The issuance of this permit hereby cancels permit no. 130940.
- 5) The use of groundwater from this well is limited to indoor use, irrigation of lawn and garden and the watering of domestic animals and livestock.
- 6) Production from this well is limited to the Dawson aquifer.
- 7) The pumping rate of this well shall not exceed 200 GPM.
- 8) The average annual amount of groundwater to be withdrawn shall not exceed 1 acre-feet and the total volume of groundwater to be withdrawn shall not exceed 300 acre-feet.
- 9) The entire length of the hole shall be geophysically logged as required by Rule 9 of the Statewide Nontributary Ground Water Rules prior to installing casing.
- 10) The owner shall mark the well in a conspicuous location with well permit number(s), name of the aquifer, and court case number(s) as appropriate. The owner shall take necessary means and precautions to preserve these markings.
- 11) A totalizing flow meter must be installed on this well and maintained in good working order. Permanent records of all diversions must be maintained by the well owner (recorded at least annually) and submitted to the Division Engineer upon request.
- 12) This well shall be constructed not more than 200 feet from the location specified on this permit.
- 13) This well shall be constructed more than 600 feet from any existing well, completed in the same aquifer, that is not owned by the applicant.
- 14) The return flow from the use of this well must be through an individual wastewater disposal system of the non-evaporative type where the water is returned to the same stream system in which the well is located.
- 15) This well is subject to administration by the Division Engineer in accordance with applicable decrees, statutes, rules, and regulations.

NOTE: This well is withdrawing water from a non-renewable aquifer. While the withdrawals from this aquifer are administered based on a 100 year aquifer life, water level declines may prevent this well from diverting the permitted amounts for that 100 years.

NOTE: This permit will expire on the expiration date unless the well is constructed and a pump is installed by that date. A Well Construction and Yield Estimate Report (GWS-31) and Pump Installation and Production Equipment Test Report (GWS-32) must be submitted to the Division of Water Resources to verify the well has been constructed and the pump has been installed.
