Please accept the following comments from El Paso County Public Health (EPCPH) regarding the 40-acre, 5 residential lot development project referenced above:

- Water service for the development will be provided by individual private wells, and wastewater service will be provided by onsite wastewater treatment systems (OWTS). The water must be sampled as required by the Land Development Code for El Paso County Public Health to make a finding for sufficiency in terms of water quality.
- An Onsite Wastewater Treatment System (OWTS) Report has not been submitted or reviewed. El Paso County Public Health requires the report to determine suitability of the site for the use of OWTS's.
- El Paso County Public Health encourages planned walkability of residential communities. Please consider appropriate connections to commercial areas through the use of sidewalks, and bike trails. Walkability features help reduce obesity and associated heart diseases.
- Earthmoving activities Earthmoving activities greater than 25 acres require a
 Construction Activity Permit from the Colorado Department of Public Health
 and Environment, Air Pollution Control Division. Go to the El Paso County
 Public Health site https://www.elpasocountyhealth.org/service/air-quality/construction-activity-application for the link to the Colorado
 Department of Public Health and Environment, Air Pollution Control Division,
 for the permit application.
- The water quality basin, if there is one planned, must have mosquito control responsibilities included as a part of the construction design and maintenance plan to help control mosquito breeding habitat and minimize the potential for West Nile Virus.
