Kent,

An engineered site plan requires complete grading and drainage details for the site. In this case the main concern is drainage runoff coming down the proposed driveway, which will require a significant amount of grading due to the steep grade. A "ditch-out" or settling area for runoff from the driveway should be provided to minimize the potential for downstream erosion impacts. In order to complete and approve the engineering review we need a grading plan showing existing and proposed contours for the driveway and home construction and the settling area or ditch proposed to control the runoff at a non-erosive velocity. The grading plan needs to be signed and stamped by a professional engineer.
