

AMENDMENT TO 1041 PERMIT – STERLING RANCH METROPOLITAN DISTRICT NO. 1 – FORCE MAIN

Section 4.201 (1) – (6): The application submission requirements for Sterling Ranch Metropolitan District's 1041 designated activities of State interest were addressed in detail in the District's 2016 Application for a Permit to Conduct designated activities. These included a water treatment facility, water storage tanks, wells, major pipelines, wastewater lift station, and an on-site/off-site wastewater force main.

The following Sections of the Application refer to the force main and remain unaffected by this amendment: (4)(d), (5)(b), (5)(c), (5)(e), (5)(h), (6)(a), (6)(c), (7)(h), (9)(b) and (10). Article 2, 4.201 Application Submission Requirements, remains unchanged except for Section (6)(a)(iii) which states that construction of the lift station and force main is anticipated to begin in late 2015 or early 2016 and be completed in late 2016 or early 2017. Construction of the lift station and force main commenced in the Spring of 2018 and are anticipated to be completed in the Fall of 2018.

The Exhibits to the Application remain unchanged except for Exhibit F and Appendix E to Exhibit O, both of which show a portion of the approved force main alignment going south from Sterling Ranch on BLH No. 2 property rather than easterly on BLH No. 2 property as proposed with this amendment. Exhibit W shows the previously approved force main alignment. The proposed alignment, as shown on the attached map, and as attached to the Letter of Intent, should be substituted for the map in Exhibit W and added to the Exhibit F and Appendix E to Exhibit O.
