RE: Letter of Intent regarding Water Delivery System for VA Cemetery

Dear Ms. Parsons,

This project is an extension of the Widefield Water and Sanitation District water system for the purpose of providing irrigation and potable water to the new Pikes Peak National Cemetery under construction on Drennan Road.

The project and VA serviced area is entirely within the existing Widefield Water District Service Area. The project consists mostly of 12 inch pipeline with a moderate amount of 18 and 16 inch pipeline. In total the project is roughly three miles in length. Most of the project will cross open lands and will include one bored crossing of Bradley Road. The attached drawings illustrate the location and extent of the project.

The project will originate in one of El Paso County's currently active developments, known as Lorson Ranch, specifically Lorson East. The project will include pipelines that will have the dual purpose of also serving the new Lorson School project being undertaken by Widefield School District #3.

The project has been through early assistance with El Paso County Planning and determined to be exempt from the 1041 process.

It is the intent to commence construction at the beginning of 2018 in order to satisfy the needs of the VA. Thankyou for your consideration.
