Dear Ryan,

I am in receipt of a referral request for comments for Black Hills Energy - Highway 94 Enoch Road -Mayberry site. The Black Hills Energy has an upcoming 6-inch steel natural gas main extension project to service the new development know as Mayberry Communities. The project will be completed along Highway 94 between Enoch Road and Peyton Highway in El Paso County, Colorado. It is located along the south border of Sec 11 & 12, T 14S, R 64W and the south border of Sec 7 & 8, T 14S, R 63W, of the 6th PM in El Paso County, Colorado. After review of all documentation, we have the following comments:

Hydraulics

The drainage documents submitted for Black Hills Energy - Highway 9+4 Enoch Road have been reviewed by a CDOT Hydraulics Engineer. Their comments follow:

Access

• CDOT Access does not have any comments.

Utilities,

- A CDOT Utility Permit is required prior to start of project. Contact Gabe Martinez with CDOT Utilities Permitting for Utility Permitting review of plans and specifications required.
- Per CDOT Utilities the bore under the State Highway is allowed.
- Minimum cover at the lowest point of the bore is required to be a minimum of 48-inches and maintained for the complete bore measured at the top of pipe. The plans show deeper grades of 6-foot and 5-foot and that is preferred.
- 3-foot depth bores at the Right of Way are not allowed.

Additionally,

• On-premise and off-premise signing shall comply with the current Colorado Outdoor Advertising Act, sections 43-1-401 to 421, C.R.S., and all rules and regulations pertaining to outdoor



advertising. Please contact Mr. Todd Ausbun at (719) 696-1403 for any questions regarding advertising devices.

• Any utility work within the state highway right of way will require a utility permit from the CDOT. Information for obtaining a utility permit can also be obtained by contacting Mr. Ausbun.
