SAFE ROUTES TO SCHOOL ANALYSIS:

The Corvallis ODP and Master Planned Community has proposed a 12-acre school site as part of the overall Corvallis development. The Corvallis development will consist of constructing sidewalks along all proposed streets including Lorson Boulevard, Rivers Boulevard, Springs Glenn Drive and Collector A. Pedestrian crosswalks will be provided to include crossings at Lorson Blvd and River Blvd roundabout, at the intersection of Rivers Blvd and Spring Glen Drive, and the intersection/roundabout where Rivers Blvd intersects with the western north-south Collector A. Internal sidewalks and trail connections will also be provided for internal circulation to connect to the main pedestrian routes. This will include pedestrian crossings and traffic control mechanisms as necessary. The proposed school site will also be utilized by the Glen at Widefield development to the south. The Glen at Widefield neighborhood sitting east of Jimmy Camp West Tributary will connect seamlessly into the sidewalks constructed along Springs Glenn Drive within Corvallis for safe routes to the Corvallis Master Planned school site. The school district will determine extent of zones for walking and busing student.

PHASING: The sidewalk on Spring Glen Drive from Glen at Widefield neighborhood will be constructed during Phase 1. All other sidewalks will be constructed with adjacent neighborhoods in order of neighborhood build out, as well as any segments needed for the built neighborhood to have complete connection to the school site.
