Falcon Field Metropolitan District, ID-19-005

Please accept the following comments from El Paso County Public Health regarding the project referenced above:

- The proposed Falcon Field Metropolitan District (FFMD) includes plans for 57.6 acres of commercial development. FFMD also has plans for trails, mosquito control, and storm water management.
- Woodmen Hills Metropolitan District (WHMD) supplies water and wastewater services. WHMD currently complies with the design criteria, and the rules and regulations established by the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment, Water Quality Control Division.
- The water quality basins proposed must have mosquito control responsibilities included as a part of the construction design and maintenance plan to help control mosquito breeding habitat and minimize the potential for West Nile Virus. Mosquito Control responsibilities are included in the FFMD Service Plan.
- Earthmoving activities greater than 25 acres require a Construction Activity Permit from the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment, Air Pollution Control Division. Go to: <https://www.colorado.gov/pacific/cdphe/general-air-permits>
- El Paso County Public Health encourages planned walk-ability of residential communities with sidewalks, walking paths, and bike trails to surrounding neighborhood parks, schools and commercial areas. Walk-ability features promote exercise, help reduce obesity and lower the risk of heart disease.
