This letter is being written to serve as a letter of commitment for emergency services coverage for Powers & Grinnell Multi-Family Development to be known as Powers & Grinnell Apts. (Assessor # 5507200003).

The Security Fire Protection District currently provides fire protection service to this area. The service provided will include structure and wildland fire coverage, response to medical situations, plan reviews, and fire inspections.

The Security Fire Protection District serves an estimated population of 50,000 people in the Security and Widefield area located in the unincorporated area of El Paso County. To serve this area we have three fire station strategically placed throughout the district to provide an average response time of less than five minutes. The three fire stations are staffed 24/7 out of our 43 career firefighters-EMS, and 25 volunteer personnel. The Security Fire Protection District has 5 fire engines, 1 ladder truck, 2 mini pumpers, 2 brush truck, 1 heavy rescue, 2 utility truck, 5 ambulance, and 2 Chiefs vehicle.

Additional construction will necessitate needed infrastructure to maintain the proper level of service to the Citizens of the Security Fire Protection District.
