RE: SF Final Plat – Falcon Meadows at Bent Grass Filing No. 3 - Drainage

Dear Kari,

The approved FDR (10/19/2022) for Falcon Meadows at Bent Grass Filing No. 3 shows that the upstream tributary acreage for Pond North (WQCV Detention Pond – Filing 2) has a calculated imperviousness of 60%. The sub-basins associated with the area where the proposed additional lot (Lots 33-39) is to be located are identified as C-1a, C-1c, C-1d, & C-1f. The total acreage associated with these sub-basins is 3.57 acres. The area designated as pavement within these four (4) sub-basins is 0.8376 acres. The area to be designated as building footprints totals 0.683 acres. Therefore, the total imperviousness within the sub-basins where the additional lot is proposed is: 1.5192 ac / 3.57 ac = 42.55%. This imperviousness does not adversely impact the capacity / design of Pond North (WQCV Detention Pond – Filing 2). With the inclusion of the additional lot within sub-basin C-1c, the % imperviousness has been reduced from 77.5% (FDR) to 41.4%. With the reduction in imperviousness, surface flows that are routed to Existing Inlet DP 41, via curb & gutter, also have been reduced and Existing Inlet DP 41 has sufficient capacity to capture flows and convey them downstream to Pond North (WQCV Detention Pond – Filing 2).

Per the provided analysis above, the addition of a lot (Lots 33-39) within the Falcon Meadows at Bent Grass Filing 3 does not have an adverse impact on the storm sewer conveyance system nor Pond North (WQCV Detention Pond – Filing 2).
