Donna,

I apologize for the delayed response. Having reviewed code revisions for El Paso County my primary concern is their blocking installation of major pipelines and facilities (gas transmission pipeline and regulator stations) within the Protection Zone defined as 105 ft from major roads. Was this prohibited all along and they are simply changing the language to now include the Protection Zone or is this a new requirement?

It limits Xcel's ability to install gas pipeline in road right of way which is my concern –we would need to install 105 ft away from major roads or 45 ft from county roads, unless they grant a special permit – am I interpreting correctly? So my question is will the county allow exceptions thru a special permit or is there no chance to install gas pipeline within a protection zone?
