FIRE PROTECTION REPORT

Project: Mountains Edge (08019)

To Whom It May Concern:

Mountains Edge is located within the Boundaries of the Peyton Fire Protection District "The District".

Response Time:

8 – 11 minutes depending on staffing, traffic and weather conditions.

Capabilities:

The District has the capability of Structural Fire Suppression, Wildland Fire Suppression, Basic Life Support Services "BLS", and Emergency Medical Services "EMS".

Existing Equipment:

Currently The District operates and maintains the following equipment:

- 1 Engine with a 1000 gallon water capacity with a 1250 gallon per minute "gpm" pump,
- 1 Tender with a 2000 gallon water capacity with a 500gpm pump,
- 1 Brush Truck with a 400 gallon water capacity with a 100gpm pump with Foam capabilities,
- 1 Brush Truck with a 400 gallon water capacity with a 100gpm pump,
- 1 Brush Truck with a 300 gallon water capacity with a 100gpm pump,
- 1 Rescue Vehicle for BLS, EMS, and Support,
- 1 Command Vehicle for Incident Command.

Future Equipment:

- 1 New Tender with 3000 gallon water capacity with a 750gpm pump "Class B Pumper",
- 1 New Engine (2nd) with a 1000 gallon water capacity with a 1250gpm pump.

Facilities:

- 1 Station located at 13665 Railroad St. Peyton, CO 80831 comprising of two buildings with 7 bays,

Future Facilities:

2 New Stations with 4 double bays, location to be determined.

Services:

We provide both Structural and Wildland Fire Suppression, Emergency Medical Services and Basic Life Support Services, and provide community fire safety education. We also respond to both Traffic and Medical situations and perform Search and Rescue.
