FENCE SCREENING NOTES:

1. SCREEN TO BE INSTALLED ON EXISTING FENCES ON WEST AND SOUTH BOUNDARIES, AND ALONG EAST BOUNDARY AS SHOWN...

GRASS REVEGETATION:

1. DISTURBED AREAS SHOULD BE REVEGETATED OR MULCHED WITHIN 45 DAYS.

2. REVEG WITH THE FOLLOWING MIXES, OR AS SPECIFIED BY ENGINEER IN DETENTION POND.

A. SHOTGUN MIX, EPCDD

B. EL PASO LOW GRO GRASS SEED MIX

## IOTES:

1. ALL LANDSCAPING IN THE TABLE ABOVE IS EXISTING AND WELL ESTABLISHED.
2. THE ELMS ON THE SOUTHERN PORTION OF THE SITE ARE MATURE AND VALUABLE TO THE HOMEGENITY OF THE NEIGHBORHOOD. THEIR PRESENCE SUPPORTS THE RESIDENTIAL BLENDING AND TRANSITION OF THE OFFICE AREA, TO THE MORE HEAVILY USED NORTHERN AREA. THE MATURITY AND HEIGHT OF THESE TREES SUFFICIENTLY MEET LANDSCAPE CODE REQUIREMENTS.

3. TWO EXISTING PINES ARE LOCATED IN THE PROPOSED DETENTION POND AREA. THESE SHALL BE RELOCATED OR REPLACED TO THE EAST OF THEIR CURRENT LOCATION AS NOTED. IF REPLACEMENT IS NECESSARY, THE TREES SHALL BE A MINIMUM OF 6' SIMILAR EVERGREEN.

4. MANUAL IRRIGATION IS APPLIED TO EXISTING VEGETATION AS NEEDED.
5. REVEGETATE DISTURBED AREAS WITH THE GRASS MIXES NOTED OR AS SPECIFIED ON THE DRAINAGE REPORT.
