Dear Mr. Heald,

This letter is in response to your "Security Water District- Water Supply Quality Mitigation Project Consideration of Exemption of El Paso County 1041 Regulations" letter dated December 4, 2018, which includes a request for an exemption of the proposed water quality mitigation project. Your letter does not outline the scope of the work to be completed, however, staff has previously met with you and received an overview of the proposal. The scope of the work includes the installation of new water lines as well as a new water treatment facility.

After reviewing your letter against the applicable sections of the El Paso County Guidelines and Regulations for Areas and Activities of State Interest ("1041 Regulations"), it is my opinion that the proposed project is subject to the County's 1041 Regulations, and therefore, will require a "1041" permit.

It is the determination of the Planning and Community Development Director that the proposed water quality mitigation project does not meet any of the exemptions listed within Section 1.105 or Section 4.104.

Please provide a pre-application submittal in order to initiate the 1041 application process.


