I do show that both systems on the property had some permitting done in 2017. I show records that an existing 1987 installation is approved for use and to my knowledge still being used. The additional 2017 installation on the system you are inquiring about was approved for use in July 2019.

Although the system is approved for use, I am unable to provide an indication of system adequacy currently.
