Sketch Plan - Southern Colorado Rail Park Sketch Plan - A request by Edw C Levy Co D/B/A Schmidt Construction Inc., for approval of a Sketch Plan consisting of 3,108.9 acres to develop a commercial, light, and heavy industrial park with a new rail spur from the existing CSU rail located at the Ray Nixon Power Plant property to the eastern boundary of the Fort Carson Military Installation. The property is located south of Charter Oak Ranch Road and west of I-25.
