AECOM was retained by the United States Army Corp of Engineers to perform the design and construction of the Drinking Water Mitigation System (DWMS) for the Security Water District, Colorado Springs, Colorado. Please see Project Summary and Construction Drawings for additional project details. The following is the Aquifer Impact Report for construction.

Aquifer Impact Report

Impacts to groundwater are not anticipated during the construction of the Security Drinking Water Mitigation Facility. According to the Security DWMS geotechnical report, groundwater was detected at 30 feet below ground surface (ft bgs). These groundwater levels were consistent with the State of Colorado Information Marketplace for Well Depths and Groundwater Elevation Data, which states groundwater generally, ranges from 20 to 80 ft bgs within the Security project site.
