Maximum height for freestanding CMRS facilities shall not exceed the maximum structure height limit in the zoning district (A-5 is 30 feet) unless authorized as part of the use approval, your Letter of Intent needs to address and specifically ask for a variance to the height requirements to allow for a 75 foot monopole

Through application for both a Site Plan Review and Variance of Use, it is AT&T's intent to construct a new 75' monopole at the above listed address for the purposes of re-locating antennas from the Colorado Springs Utilities/Fountain Valley Authority Water Tower to the new monopole. This re-location is at the request of the Colorado Springs Utilities/Fountain Valley Authority who requested the antennas be removed for their internal purposes of tower painting, maintenance, etc. (See attached letter dated 2/1/2015). AT&T has worked hard to come up with a solution that works for the utilities as well as continues to provide service to this area of I-25. If the monopole is not constructed, the lease will terminate at the end of the year, resulting in a Public Safety Hazard along this portion of the I-25

This new construction will include the following:

facility, due to the loss of this site.

- Construction of a new 75' monopole for re-location of the antennas currently on the water tank.
- Construction of a new 150' x 12' vehicle access to the monopole from an existing access along the East side of the water treatment ponds.

corridor and surrounding area, including the Fountain Valley Authority / Colorado Springs Utilities

- Laying approximately 300' of buried conduit from the existing equipment location to the new tower.

The ground equipment for the tower will remain in its present location next to the water tank and no changes will be made to its structure/layout. Additionally, no other changes will occur on the parcel beyond the 3 construction items listed above.

Construction of this tower will begin as soon as approval is granted with an anticipated construction start date in August 2017.
