In addition, Core Engineering Group has verified in a separate certification letter dated May 4, 2023 that Extended Detention Basin/WQ Pond C2.1 and WQ Pond F (April 10, 2023) which serve this site, meets the volume and elevation requirements and are constructed in general compliance with the approved construction plans.

Based on information gathered during construction and post-construction, Core Engineering Group is of the opinion that the public streets, storm sewer, and Detention Pond C2.1 and WQ Pond F have been constructed in general accordance with the approved construction documents.
