This letter is in response to your request for comment on the "Woodmoor Water & Sanitation District No. 1 Central Water Treatment Plant Improvements Project 1041 Administrative Determination Request JVA Job No. 1051.5e" letter dated June 24, 2020. The proposed action includes updating equipment that has reached the end of its useful life and to retrofit an existing facility with new technology to treat surface water of an existing Site Approval (U-93-003). The action will not result in an increase to the hydraulic or organic capacity of the existing treatment facility.

After reviewing your letter addressing the applicable sections of the El Paso County Guidelines and Regulations for Areas and Activities of State Interest ("1041 Regulations"), it is my opinion that the proposed project is not subject to the County's 1041 Regulations. Please be advised that this determination is limited to the project as proposed. Additional review(s) for applicability of the 1041 Regulations will be required by the County for any future change(s) to the facility.

The current proposal shows a boundary line adjustment and an additional structure and as such an administrative vacation and replat will be required per Section 7.2.4 of the
