

FOR AREAS WITH 3:1 SLOPES OR GREATER CONTRACTOR TO USE SOIL GUARD APPLICATION ONLY (IN LIEU OF HYDROMULCH) CONTRACTOR TO SPOT SEED NON-GERMINATING AREAS (3) MONTHS AFTER INITIAL SEED APPLICATION.
