Crown Castle USA Inc. ("Crown Castle") on behalf of T-Mobile West LLC ("T-Mobile") is submitting the attached Eligible Facilities Request application to add transmission equipment on a telecommunications tower located at 231 Main Street, COLORADO SPRINGS, CO 80911 in CITY OF FOUNTAIN, CO (the "KEEBLER/ COLORADO SPGS/ CSP209 Tower").

Section 6409 of the Middle Class Tax Relief and Job Creation Act of 2012, commonly known as the "Spectrum Act" (Pub. Law No. 112-96, 126 Stat 156), mandates that state and local governments "may not deny, and shall approve, any eligible facilities request for a modification of an existing wireless tower or base station that does not substantially change the physical dimensions of such tower or base station." Additionally, if "the reviewing State or local government determines that the application is incomplete" [they] "must provide written notice to the applicant within 30 days of receipt of the application, clearly and specifically delineating all missing documents or information." Under federal law, an Eligible Facilities Request is deemed granted with written notification in sixty (60) days after an application is filed with a local jurisdiction, excluding tolling. **Based on the submittal date of September 13, 2018, 30 days will expire on October 13, 2018; 60 days will expire on November 12, 2018.**

T-Mobile proposes to modify the "KEEBLER/ COLORADO SPGS/ CSP209 Tower" as follows:

Tower Scope: TMO proposes to install (6) antennas, (6) RRU, (2) raycaps and (2) hybrid.

Ground Scope: New T-Mobile pad inside existing lease area. Installing (1) SSC cabinet, (1) COVP, (1) fiber Ciena, (1) PPC power unit, and (1) steel cube
