Woodmen Hills Metropolitan District (WHMD, the District) has been approached to potentially provide wastewater service for future development that lies on approximately 765 acres of land, roughly 1.3 miles northeast of the intersection of Stapleton Road and U.S. Highway 24. There are roughly 3,200 Single Family Equivalents (SFE's) proposed within this subdivision entitled Grandview Reserve.

As the regional wastewater treatment provider in the area, the District may possibly have excess capacity to serve future development contingent upon a potential service agreement, a future Intergovernmental Agreement (IGA) between the two agencies, and possible inclusion into the District.
