Christy,

To clarify, you are not within a designated groundwater basin. As such, there will not be a determination of water rights. Instead, as the property is outside of the designated basin, there will be an adjudication by the water court. We are currently waiting on the Chief Judge to approve the consolidation of the cases in Division 2. I'm hoping this happens any day now. After that, we will immediately file a proposed decree with the water court. The water referee will then check with the division engineer to see if he is okay with the decree and then sign it. I hope this will occur within a couple of weeks after the order from the Chief Judge for consolidation. After the water referee signs, there is a 21-day waiting period and then the judge will sign and it will be final.
