The U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service (Service) has reviewed the documents from April 1 and 2, 2021 associated with the property at [515 Struthers Loop](#) in Colorado Springs, CO. The Service has no concerns with this project resulting in impacts to species listed as candidate, proposed, threatened, or endangered.

The Threatened and Endangered Species Habitat Assessment discussed Black Rail habitat in the St. Vrain Creek area, but we agree the project's site within the Jackson Creek drainage does not support the species.
