This letter serves as a detailed letter accompanying the revisions to the Development Plan first submittal set for Frontier Sportsman's Club at the address 3385 Pheasant Lane in the town of Peyton, county of El Paso, state of Colorado. The County review comments are listed as presented in the Memorandum for the First Submittal dated February 11, 2020. Owner/develop and/or design team responses to said comments are provided below each item. Responses following "MT2" represent comment responses from the general contractor MT2, LLC., responses following "RMG" represent comment responses from the design engineer RMG-Rocky Mountain Group (Richard Lyon, PE). All resubmittal documents and supplemental information requested per the County review comment letter are acknowledged.

Drainage Report

1. Cursory comments only. Please provide a report that meets El Paso County Criteria. We recommend the use of a checklist that can be found on the Planning and Community Development website.

RMG: Checklist has been consulted and comments on Drainage Report have been addressed. It would be helpful if this checklist was available on the Standards and Checklist portion of the County website: https://planningdevelopment.elpasoco.com/planning-community-development/engineering/#1519834362627-c268a2b9-61ec. Are the current links directed to the most up to date revisions for the Standard Signature Blocks and GEC-SWMP Checklists?

2. The proposed berm/dam on the unnamed tributary needs to be evaluated and discussed, this appears to be a Jurisdictional Dam that will need to be permitted through the State Engineers office. Additionally the water rights for the impunded water needs to be discussed and permitted.

RMG: The grading design has been revised to eliminate the berm that would be considered a jurisdictional dam.

3. Indicate the Drainage Basin and the study associated with this area and address any need for detention if necessary.

RMG: No detention or WQCV is required as there is no proposed impervious area. Language to the effect of "land disturbance to undeveloped land that will remain undeveloped per section I.7.1.B.7 of the El Paso County ECM" is used throughout the report.

4. Address SWQCV, the proposed development requires a facility that meets El Paso County criteria .

5. Provide a complete list of reference material that addresses the drainage for this site, and include portions of these documents to support the drainage design proposed.
