

PLAT NOTES

1. Unless otherwise indicated, all side, front, and rear lot lines are hereby platted on either side with a 10 foot public utility and drainage easement unless otherwise indicated. All exterior subdivision boundaries are hereby platted with a 20 foot public utility and drainage easement. The sole responsibility for maintenance of these easements is hereby vested with the individual property owners.

2. The addresses exhibited on this plat are for informational purposes only. They are not the legal description and are subject to change.

3. Mailboxes shall be installed in accordance with all El Paso County and United States Postal Service regulations.

4. Sewage treatment is the responsibility of each individual property owner. The El Paso County Department of Health and Environment must approve each system and, in some cases the Department may require an engineer designed system prior to permit approval. These systems may cost more to design, install, and maintain.

5. Individual wells are the responsibility of each property owner. Permits for individual wells must be obtained from the State Engineer who by law has the authority to set conditions for the issuance of these permits.

6. No build area designated for emergency vehicle turnaround.

7. The Federal Emergency Management Agency, Flood Insurance Rate Map No. 08041C0310G, effective date of December 07, 2018, indicates this parcel of land to be located in Zone X (Areas of minimal flood hazard).

8. The Parcel is currently Zoned RR-5.

9. Goshawk road per Private Easement Book 2356, Page 170 Reception No. 74410 provides access from the property to the County maintained road.

10. All property owners are responsible for maintaining proper storm water drainage in and through their property. Public drainage easements as specifically noted on the plat shall be maintained by the individual lot owners unless otherwise indicated. Structures, fences, materials or landscaping that could impede the flow of runoff shall not be placed in drainage easements.

11. The Subdivider(s) agrees on behalf of him/herself and any developer or builder successors and assignees that Subdivider and/or said successors and assigns shall be required to pay traffic impact fees in accordance with the El Paso County Road Impact Fee Program Resolution (Resolution No. 19-471), or any amendments thereto, at or prior to the time of building permit submittal. The fee obligation, if not paid at final plat recording, shall be documented on all sales documents and on plat notes to ensure that a title search would find the fee obligation before sale of the property.

12. Individual lot purchasers are responsible for constructing driveways, including necessary drainage culverts from Goshawk Road per Land Development Code Section 6.3.3.C.2 and 6.3.3.C.3. Due to their length, some of the driveways will need to be specifically approved by the (name of Fire District

13. The private roads as shown on this plat will not be maintained by El Paso County until and unless the streets are constructed in conformance with El Paso County standards in effect at the date of the request for dedication and maintenance.

14. Mailboxes shall be installed in accordance with all El Paso County and United States Postal Service regulations.

15. The recommendations included in the Wastewater Study and Soils and Geologic Hazards Study prepared by Rocky Mountain Group and on file with the subdivision application should be strictly adhered to.




