

MIDTOWN AT HANNAH RIDGE FILING NO. 1 AND 2 FIRE PROTECTION REPORT

December 10, 2018

Proposed Midtown at Hannah Ridge Filing No. 1 and 2 are located in both the Cimarron Hills Fire Protection District (CHFPD) and Falcon Fire Protection District (FFPD). Both districts have agreed to serve the property through existing mutual aid agreements and have facilities in the area. Filing No. 1 is entirely within FFPD service area and Filing No. 2 is within CHFPD.

FFPD

FFPD has four fire stations throughout the district with a fifth under construction less than one mile from the proposed subdivision site. The next closest station is at Meridian and Hwy 24 (7.5 miles away). The current average response time to the proposed subdivision area is 6:46 minutes. This time will significantly decrease upon completion of the new fire station in 2018. The District has the following equipment:

- Three Fire Engines (A fourth engine is due to be acquired April 2017)
- Four Water Tenders
- Two Utility Trucks
- Four Brush Trucks
- One Command Vehicle
- One AMR Ambulance

The District is staffed with 7 full-time Firefighters/EMT, 5 Firefighter/Driver Operator/EMT, 1 Firefighter/Paramedic, 6 Lieutenants and 5 Administrative officers, including the Chief. The District has 24 trained Volunteer Reserves available. The District also participates in mutual aid response with surrounding fire districts and fire departments.

The District carries an ISO Rating of Class 3/10. The rating is 3 for area within 5 miles of a fire station and 10 for areas farther than 5 miles. Proposed Hannah Ridge at Feathergrass Filings No. 5, 6 and 7 will be constructed with water mains and fire hydrants in accordance with the District's requirements and review criteria.

CHFPD

CHFPD has two fire stations in the District. The fire station is approximately 1.8 miles from the proposed subdivision site. The average response time for the last 12 month period is 4:38 throughout the district area.

- One Ladder Company
- One Engine Company
- One Squad and Brush Company
- Four Brush Trucks
- One Command Vehicle
- One AMR Ambulance

The District is full time staffed with 22 Firefighters, 4 Driver/Engineers, 3 Lieutenants, and 6 Administrative officers, including the Chief. The District has 24 trained Volunteer Reserves available. The District also participates in mutual aid response with surrounding fire districts and fire departments.

Proposed Midtown at Hannah Ridge Filing No. 1 and 2 will be constructed with water mains and fire hydrants in accordance with the two District's requirements and review criteria.
