Please accept the following updated comments from El Paso County Public Health (EPCPH) regarding the 145.2 acre, 106 residential lot development project referenced above:

- Water service will be provided by Widefield Water and Sanitation District (PWSID# CO0121900). There is a finding for sufficiency in terms of water quality for water from Widefield Water and Sanitation Districts. A Letter of Commitment dated 07Nov2017 from WWSD to serve both water and wastewater services has been submitted and reviewed.
- Wastewater service will be provided by Widefield Water and Sanitation District (WWSD). The WWSD does have sufficient treatment capacity for the proposed 145.2 acre, 106 residential lot development.
- El Paso County Public Health encourages planned walk-ability of residential communities. Please consider appropriate connections to commercial areas through the use of sidewalks, and bike trails. Walk-ability features help reduce obesity and associated heart diseases.
- The water quality detention basins maintained by Glen Metropolitan District #3 must have mosquito control responsibilities included as a part of the maintenance plan to help control mosquito breeding habitat and minimize the potential for West Nile Virus.
- Earthmoving activities Earthmoving activities greater than 25 acres require a
 Construction Activity Permit from the Colorado Department of Public Health
 and Environment, Air Pollution Control Division. Go to the El Paso County
