To Whom It May Concern:

We have received the submittal concerning the above referenced proposal to approve a Final Plat for Eldorado Springs Apartments. This proposal is for the creation of two lots on $15.55 \pm acres$. The first lot being 3.06 acres for 236 multi-family units and the second lot being a separate tract for unspecified purposes. According to the submittal, the proposed supply of water and wastewater disposal is to be served by the Stratmoor Hills Water & Sanitation District ("District").

This proposal appears to be a revision of a previous proposal, called Independence Place at Cheyenne Mountain, Filing no. 1 on which we provided comments in a letter dated March 8, 2016.

The current referral for a Final Plat does not change the water supply requirements for the subdivision; therefore, please refer to our previous comments attached to this letter, although the previous submittal proposed 240 multi-family units.

There was no estimation of the water supply demand for proposed southern tract. Therefore, the comments provided herein assume there will be no demand of water on the proposed Lot 2. Since the proposed southern tract has no estimated water demand, the plat must clearly state that the southern tract has no approved water supply.
