Hello,

I sent an email on May 19, 2020 requesting an update on the status of SF1829 and informing you that the project would be closed out. The Eagle Rising Preliminary Plan was approved by the Board of County Commissioners on September 24, 2013 (SP-12-006). Notation No. 2 includes the following language:

2. **Approval of the preliminary plan will expire after two (2) years unless a final plat has been approved and recorded or a time extension has been granted.**

The preliminary plan has been expired. The file will be closed out as the final plat cannot be processed without a valid preliminary plan. Staff has previously setup a reconsideration of an expired preliminary plan (submission request sent 12/3/2018). No application has been received for the reconsideration.

The applicant will need to come in for an early assistance meeting if they choose to develop/subdivide the property. Please let me know if you have any questions. Have a wonderful 4th of July weekend!
