It looks like we overlooked the cancellation of 5 acre-feet under 1765-BD when first discussing your plans for a well. The Liss's cancelled a portion (5 acre-feet) underlying 39.07 acres, dated Nov. 22, 2017. At this point they can't deed over more water than is available under the 39.07 acre parcel.

Attached is the Amendment for 1765-BD. Under 2.a. 5 acre-feet is being withdrawn from 39.07 acres that are a portion of the 404.92 acres. 2.c identifies the parcel as Parcel 1. Page 2 #4. identifies 20.8 acre-feet remaining in the Dawson, underlying 39.07 acres.

I keep wondering if you need a commercial well permit. If the kennel is less than 51% of your income you don't need a commercial well permit. You are covered under the domestic use of the permit #307667 and you only need to submit a change in ownership.

Otherwise, yes, (I'll write in) cancel for referenced permit #307667 and and change the annual appropriation to 3.05 acre-feet. You don't need to submit change in ownership if you're cancelling permit no. 307667.

At any rate, your deed should be corrected to 20.08 acre-feet.
