**PROPOSED LAND USE:** Single family residential

**INTRODUCTION:** The owner intends to subdivide a single unplatted lot into two rural residential lots. The minimum lot size will be five acres as required by the existing zoning. Commitment letters have been obtained for all necessary utilities. As part of this submittal, a single family residence is to be built on the proposed Lot 1.

**ACCESS:** Access will be achieved through an existing 30' access easement off of an existing public road.

**Wildland Fire & Hazard Mitigation:** A Wildland Fire & Hazard Mitigation plan has been submitted for this development.

**Fire Code Compliance:** The owners will adhere to the current approved version of the El Paso County Land Development Code, Section 6.3.3 subsections C(1) Water Supply, C(2)(3) Roads, C(4) Gates and section D, Construction in Wildland Fire Areas, in their entirety.

**WATER SUPPLY:** Fire suppression water supply will be addressed at the time of home building permits.

**REPORT:** 3275 Center Ice View is located in the Monument Fire District service area and they have committed to continue providing services to this site.

The District has 5 fire stations and an administration office. The closest station to the site is Fire Station 4, located at 15415 Gleneagle Drive, which is approximately 5.3 miles away from the proposed subdivision.

The Monument Fire Protection District has three fire engines, three ambulances, one tower ladder, three brush trucks, two water tenders, several command vehicles, one snowcat, one ATV, and it maintains a fleet of reserve apparatus. In 2023, the district will take delivery of a new Type 1 Engine, tower ladder, and Type 3 Wildland Engine. The Operations Division of the District includes 14 firefighters, 4 paramedics, 12 firefighter/paramedics, 13 engineers, 14 lieutenants, 4 battalion chiefs, and a division chief. The operations division is an all-hazards response organization that is prepared and trained to mitigate emergency incidents such as: emergency medical services, motor vehicle accidents/extrication, physical entrapments, fire suppression, wildland fire, odor investigations, gas leaks, hazardous materials, and technical rescue.

The ISO rating for the proposed subdivision would be 3Y.

The District has stated that the response time for this subdivision is less than 11 minutes.
