DEVIATION REQUEST (Attach diagrams, figures, and other documentation to clarify request)

A deviation from the standards of or in Section **2.5.2.C.4** of the Engineering Criteria Manual (ECM) is requested.

Identify the specific ECM standard which a deviation is requested:

ECM Section 2.5.2.C.4 Mid-Block Ramps on Local Roadways. Curb ramps on local roadways shall be spaced not greater than 600 feet apart. Where spacing is greater than 600 feet, mid-block curb ramps shall be provided at spacing's that minimize travel distances between curb ramps. Private accesses may be used for these access points where the access is designed to meet curb ramp requirements. The pavement markings and signing required by the ECM and MUTCD shall be provided for mid-block curb ramps.

State the reason for the requested deviation:

Mid-block pedestrian crossings are not required by Federal/ADA regulations, they are provided as an increased convenience for people walking and accessibility support for those with physical limitations and people with disabilities.

Explain the proposed alternative and compare to the ECM standards (May provide applicable regional or national standards used as basis):

We are requesting to reduce the number of mid-block pedestrian ramps on Keynes Drive, Kingsbury Drive and Country Manor Drive. Curb ramps are provided at the intersecting streets and we are providing one mid-block pedestrian crossing on Keynes Drive, Kingsbury Drive and Country Manor Drive in lieu of at 600 foot intervals. This will provide the needed accessibility and convenience required.

Mid-block pedestrian crossings are not required by Federal/ADA regulations, they are provided as an increased convenience.

Curb ramps are provided at the intersecting streets and we are providing one mid-block pedestrian crossing on Keynes Drive, Kingsbury Drive and Country Manor Drive which will achieve a comparable design.

The deviation will not adversely affect safety or operations, as it is not required but more of a convenience.

The deviation will not adversely affect maintenance and its associated cost.

There will be less of a maintenance problem as there are less crossings to maintain.

The deviation will not adversely affect aesthetic appearance.

ECM ADMINISTRATOR COMMENTS/CONDITIONS:

1.1. PURPOSE

The purpose of this resource is to provide a form for documenting the findings and decision by the ECM Administrator concerning a deviation request. The form is used to document the review and decision concerning a requested deviation. The request and decision concerning each deviation from a specific section of the ECM shall be recorded on a separate form.

1.2. BACKGROUND

A deviation is a critical aspect of the review process and needs to be documented to ensure that the deviations granted are applied to a specific development application in conformance with the criteria for approval and that the action is documented as such requests can point to potential needed revisions to the ECM.

1.3. APPLICABLE STATUTES AND REGULATIONS

- A change to a standard is required to address a specific design or construction problem, and if not modified, the standard will impose an undue hardship on the applicant with little or no material benefit to the public.

1.5. TECHNICAL GUIDANCE

The review shall ensure all criteria for approval are adequately considered and that justification for the deviation is properly documented.

1.6. LIMITS OF APPROVAL

Whether a request for deviation is approved as proposed or with conditions, the approval is for project-specific use and shall not constitute a precedent or general deviation from these Standards.

1.7. REVIEW FEES

A Deviation Review Fee shall be paid in full at the time of submission of a request for deviation. The fee for Deviation Review shall be as determined by resolution of the BoCC.
