Notes (Describe the issue for the Commissioner): Dear El Paso County Commissioners: We are writing in opposition to the approval of the rezoning of the subject property to an RV park. It will have a negative impact on our community as we have no amenities for Rver's in the Peyton area. The reason we moved to Peyton was for the agricultural aspect of the community, not for an RV park. We count on the Commissioners and the current zoning to protect our investment and way of life. Our current subdivision is A35. On that note, we maintain our roads out of our own pockets. The county does NOT maintain our private roads. We have drivers cutting through our roads to try to access Highway 24. We had to put a gate up to stop the traffic as the maps still show our road connecting to 24. A semi truck came through at one point and couldn't turn around so he blew through the gate. The applicants do not mention Elliott View in their proposal. Elliott View services 10 different property owners. There is a school bus stop on Peyton Highway at Elliott View (the private road we refer to in this letter). This school bus stop is not far from the proposed main entrance to the RV Park. There is a blind hill just south of the school bus stop. The County even put up signs warning traffic of the blind hill. This is extremely dangerous for the children accessing the bus. The agricultural history of El Paso County needs to be preserved, as the current residents of this area own their property because of the current zoning, and that is being jeopardized by a property owner who wishes to rezone to a commercial property. Peyton Highway cannot accommodate the huge influx of traffic that this RV park can/will bring. There are no turn lanes to accommodate a huge RV possibly pulling another vehicle, into and out of the RV park which creates another whole safety issue.
