Palmer-Williams Creek Solar, PPR-19-006

Please accept the following comments from El Paso County Public Health regarding the two proposed solar energy sites. There are 711 acres of land area combined between the two sites.

- El Paso County Public Health understands the facility will not require wastewater services after the construction of the facility has been completed. Portable sanitary facilities are for temporary use only and must be removed when construction is completed.
- El Paso County Public Health also understands water service for the project will be provided by local water purveyors. Water will be used for cleaning of the solar panels usually only two times per year once the facility is in operation.
- Water will also be used for dust control during construction of the facility as required for compliance with the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment, Air Pollutant Emission Notice (APEN).
